obsession, from tears and depression, from untold excesses, from


treasured successes, to meet, to eat, be given a seat, be joined to the vine,

Leader: These words, and the many more that are silent and hidden, we pray to you, the God who listens, forgives and loves us time and time again. In our prayers, we affirm:


People: God welcomes all, strangers and friends. God's love is strong and it never ends.


