### **About the Music:**

The reformer Martin Luther believed that the congregation needed to be able to understand the Scripture reading, the sermon, and the singing. One of his major accomplishments was the translation of the Bible into German. Another was the establishment of congregational singing. Luther's German masses included chorales, which are similar to many of the hymns we sing today. Chorales were designed to be sung in unison. They consisted of easily memorized melodies and simple rhythmic patterns. *A Mighty Fortress Is Our God* found at #259-260 in the Presbyterian Hymnal is an excellent example of a chorale. If you are familiar with rhythmic notation, you will notice how different the two settings are. #259 is the original version; the rhythm of #260 has been smoothed out. The tune is attributed to Luther himself.

Luther did not object to a choir in his services, and certainly the voices of a choir are extremely helpful in leading congregations in singing hymns. However, John Calvin preferred quite a different approach to music in worship. What was it? See an upcoming About the Music.

All of the congregational hymns and songs will be included in the new Presbyterian hymnal, which is scheduled to arrive early this fall.

### **Choir rehearsals have resumed and you are welcome to join us!**

The choir has resumed rehearsing for our role as leaders of worship through music. We meet on Wednesday evenings at **7:15 p.m.** The choir will explore a wide variety of music this year — some gospel songs, some pieces by classical composers, settings of beloved hymn texts and scriptural texts, and more. Plans for Advent and Lenten cantatas are in the making, and the choir will lead in a hymn festival when the new hymnals arrive this fall. The choir would gladly welcome anyone who would like to join us. Just come to rehearsal on any Wednesday if you would like to participate.
